Course Registration	The students can register for the selected courses after their arrival and enrolment at the IUAS. Please communicate with your departmental coordinator.
Homeworks/Exams	Homework and exam requirements may vary depending on the course. Please communicate with the instructor beforehand.
Thesis/Project Work	It may be possible to conduct a theses work, but it must be communicated with the departmental coordinator and a local advisor should be assigned.
Transcript of Records	The Transcript of Records (ToR) will be prepared and sent to the student's home address after the Erasmus Office has received all grades of the student's courses.
PRACTICAL INFORMATION	
Campuses	IUAS has several campuses throughout the province of Isparta. Faculties of Technology, Forestry, Agriculture and Fisheries are located in the main campus in the city of Isparta. Faculty of Tourism is located in Eğirdir (30 km from the city of Isparta). Other colleges and vocational schools are distributed in different campuses with varying distances. Please see the official website for details.
Cost of Living	The average cost of living in Isparta for one semester is approximately 300 € per month, including food, insurance, housing etc.
Accommodation	There is a guest house and several dormitories on the central campus in Isparta. There is also the possibility to live in private dormitories or flats offcampus. The cost of accommodation will vary between 35 and 150 Euros per months and usually incudes utilities.
Food	Lunch is offered at a discount price (approximately € 0.75) in student restaurants. There are several other restaurants and cafeterias on the central campus. A meal at a local restaurant may cost around 2-5 Euros.
Travel	Isparta can be easily reached via Antalya international airport (120 km distance), which provides good choice of direct flights to most major European airports. Connecting flights are also possible via domestic airports in Isparta (35 km) or in Denizli (120 km). Ground transportation via intercity busses can be favorable to reach nearby destinations outside the city limits. Urban transportation is provided by public busses.

<p>Visa and Residence Permit</p>	<p>EU citizens do not need to make a visa application before they come to Turkey. At the gates, the students will get a 3-month touristic visa. However, foreigners who intend to study in Turkey must apply for a residence permit immediately upon their arrival in Turkey regardless of the validity of their visa. Communication Center for Foreigners operating under the Directorate General of Migration Management provides consultancy and support to foreigners 24 hours a day and 7 days a week at 157 hotline from within Turkey and +90 312 157 11 22 from abroad.</p> <p>For more information: https://en.goc.gov.tr/, https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/</p>
<p>Health Care System</p>	<p>Students have basically two choices: They can either bring a proof of their insurance or buy an insurance policy in Turkey.</p> <p>If the students are already insured at their home country, their insurance must be approved by Turkish Social Security Institution (Sosyal Güvenlik Kurumu, SGK) via inter-governmental agreements to be effective in Turkey. It is also advisable to choose a company which has branches in Turkey.</p> <p>Students may choose to buy insurance from a private insurer or get the state insurance in Turkey. The private insurers allow the students to receive free health care in contracted hospitals within the limits specified in the policy and costs about 30-60 Euros per year. General Health Insurance provided with the state agencies (SGK) allows the students to get free health services in all state hospitals, while they will need to pay varying amounts of contributions in private hospitals. The state insurance costs about 120-180 Euros per year.</p>
